5. Attach rationale, description and learning outcomes as determined in consultation with your Individually-Designed Interdisciplinary Major/Minor adviser. College of Arts & Sciences students must provide a letter of recommendation and signature from faculty member other than the adviser, as indicated in Section 4.
6. Submit the completed form with all the signatures in Section 4 and required attachments to the college of your primary major.
