Neurodiversity

Over the next decade, an estimated 500,000 neurodivergent teens (50,000 each year) will enter adulthood.

That the unemployment rate among neurodivergent individuals is 30 to 40%. When considering only autistic individuals with a college degree, the unemployment rate climbs to 85%.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention estimates that 1 in 36 children in the United States is diagnosed with neurodiversity.

Professional work experiences increase the likelihood of employment upon graduation.
