Please note that at the time of matriculation to the program, all students will be asked to complete a caregiver background check. This process must be completed before a student is given permission to register for classes. Issues that might arise from the background check must be considered in the context of practicum/internship placement as well as eventual licensure, and the program director will discuss this with the student to determine how to proceed.

Applicants and students should be aware that in order to pursue licensure as a counselor post-graduation, criminal arrests or convictions may impact or impede an applicant's ability to become licensed. Because the types of charges that may impact licensure vary by state, we recommend that individuals who have an open arrest or conviction, or any concerns regarding a background check, consult with the state licensing board in their state and seek professional advice about their individual situation.

The student will take responsibility for ensuring that the site supervisor has been provided a copy of the course syllabus each semester, a copy of the Practicum and Internship Handbook and evaluation forms to be completed at the end of each semester, the supervision agreement has been signed by all parties, and the initial PLA/ILA and revisited PLA/ILA has been reviewed and signed by all parties.
