Applicants who have met prerequisites (d) and (e) below at the time of nomination will have an advantage over those who anticipate completing them in the coming year. Thereview committee will consider applicants's enior program progress when ranking the applications Doctoral students must:

- a. Haveno doctoral gradeless than B.
- b. Havepassedhe qualifyingexamination by the time of nomination.
- c. Havebeenadvancedo candidacyby the time of nomination.
- d. Havean approved doctoral program planning form on file by the time they begin the fellowship (August).
- e. Havean approved dissertation outline on file by the time they begin the fellowship (August).
- f. Showexcellentpotential for a distinguished cademior professionabareer.
- g. Planto be a full time student resident at Marquette University during their fellowship year.
- h. Not acceptany outside employment during the term of their fellowship. Other previously accepted Graduate Schoolssistantships rellowships for the same term must be resigned before commencing the Raynor Fellowship.

Eligibility Requirements or Master's Students:

- a. Must have an outstanding under graduate record.
- b. Must have a GPA of at least 3.75 in their graduate courses with no gradeless than a B.
- c. Must have completed the equivalent of one semester of full time coursework (the current fall semester can be used, contingent on the grades for the semester) and be enrolled full r time in the following spring semester.
- d. Must showgreat potential for excellence in doctoral studies or for a distinguished professionabareer.
- e. Must plan to be a full time student resident at Marquette University during the fellowship year.
