Haggerty Museum Featured on Milwaukee Public Television

The Haggerty Museum will be featured in two episodes of ¡Adelante!, a weekly, locally produced television series celebrating the rich heritage of Latino people. The program airs in Spanish with subtitles in English. Program segments originally taped in English are captioned in Spanish.

The Haggerty segments focus on the current exhibition Clear Picture: Looking at Communities from an Art Museum and the Fall 2015 exhibition What is Hispanic? Interviews for the segments were conducted with Marquette professors Dr. Scott Dale and Dr. Eugenia Afinoguénova (Associate Professors of Spanish, Department of Foreign Languages and Literatures) and Lynne Shumow, the Haggerty's curator of education.
