- History: The Augustinians follow the rule of Augustine (354-430), bishop of Hippo. They were canonically organized in 1256 and made their first U.S. foundation in 1969. The Augustinians have administered the St. Augustine Province (San Diego, California), which included Indian missions and parishes in the United States, 1986-2002.
- Holdings of Catholic-related records about Native Americans in the United States are unknown.
