Overview

The Accelerated Degree Policy (ADP) is designed to provide Marquette University undergraduates a more efficient means to obtginaduatedegree or certificate. The program benefits the university by retaining our best students for graduate. Minimum academic criteria are established by each participating unit for students who have a high academic potential (typically 3.000 or above) and want to start takingduatelevel courses during their undergraduate careers, some of which will count toward both their undergraduateadegree graduate degree or certificate.

Graduate programs offering this option grant undergraduates early acceptant thate School and allow a specified number of graduate credits to be counted toward the student's undergraduate degree and graduate degree or certificate.
