## B. Credentialing at the Graduate/Professional Level

The following qualifications for the credentials to perform various duties at the graduate/professional level represent minimal requirements. All faculty qualified at the graduate level are automatically qualified at the undergraduate level for the respective discipline/subfield.

### 1. Oredentials needed to teach graduate/professional courses

a. The individual must have a doctorate/terminal degree in the discipline for which they will serve as instructor of record for courses. Doctorate/terminal degrees in will be accepted, but the home departments must determine the degrees that are considered closely related by disciplinary standards and indicate

b. In addition, the individual must have a history of engaging in scholarship (e.g., publishing a book, peer-reviewed article, or disciplinary equivalent) in the area.

### 4. Credentials needed

Terminal degrees in will be accepted, but the home departments must determine the degrees that are considered closely related by disciplinary standards form.

In instances where a project/thesis/dissertation committee is being co-chaired, at least one co-chair must meet this eligibility requirement.

# C. Special Appointment

There may be times when a uniquely qualified person, such as an individual from another university, government, industry, or the arts and may be given a Special Appointment for a specific duty and for a fixed period of time within undergraduate or graduate education.
